<u>REAR</u>: With the vehicle on level ground, block the front tires. Using a floor jack, raise the rear end and support the frame rails with jack stands for safety. Remove rear tires.

NOTE: Never work under an unsupported vehicle.

1. Remove factory shocks by first removing the lower mounting bolt using a 21mm socket on the head of the bolt and a 24mm wrench on the nut.

2. Remove upper bolts using a 16mm socket on a long extension and remove shock from vehicle.





Remove the two lower push pins holding the fender liner to gain access to the upper mount when installing the King Shocks.



3. Install King Shocks by first installing the upper mounting brackets using the factory bolts. Remove upper mounting brackets (25035-102) from the shocks and install on vehicle first.



4. Place shock in position so that the reservoir is towards the rear of the vehicle and install the 1/2" x 2.75" bolts (CB4730) with washers (CW1702) and nuts (CN2801) in the upper mount first. **Torque bolts to 110 ft/lbs** using a 3/4 wrench/socket.

5. Install the provided 16mm bolts (CB3831) with washers (CW1803) and nuts (CN3003) in the lower mount and tighten with a 24mm Socket and wrench.





6. Replace the plastic push pins for the fender liner and you are done installing rear shocks!

DOUBLE CHECK ALL HARDWARE:
