1. Remove the stock steering stabilizer by removing the nuts using a 17mm wrench or socket.

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2. Install King Steering Stabilizer by placing the tapered spacers into the factory mounting points in the same orientation as the factory stabilizer, see photos below. Use the hardware provided in the kit to attach the steering stabilizer.





3. Tighten both mounting bolts using a 17mm wrench/socket.

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Double check your install, make sure the stabilizer is mounted properly and all hardware is tight. Recheck the hardware after 100 miles and periodically after that as part of routine maintenance.

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
